First come, first serve basis will apply for registration.

A copy of the Artistic Approach (50 words), contact information (e.g. e-mail, telephone and website) and five pictures of work pieces including size representing the style being exhibited must be sent to bonjour@artsvisuelsgatineau.com. This information will be used to publicize the event.

AVG provides the booth (grids 12 feet wide by 7 feet high) a small poster with name and booth number. Sculptors must bring their own pedestals.

It is recommended that each participant have their own **black drapes** to be installed behind each grid. Some black drapes are available on demand. Drapes and tablecloths must be black.

Participants are responsible for setting up and dismantling their booth

- Set-up takes place on the evening of April 25th or during the day on Friday, April 26th.
- Participants must have their own hooks, LED lighting, extension cords and power bar. Masking tape and Scotch tape must not be used on grids.
- All artworks must be presented professionally. Each art piece must be identified with title, medium and price.
- A small table (max 2 square feet) is allowed for business card and greeting cards. However, easels
 are not allowed. If a display stand is used, it must not obstruct the neighbouring booth. 6-foot tables
 are permitted for artisans only.

Artwork must be unique and original.

<u>Are not allowed:</u> Copies of an original artwork, reproductions nor plagiarism.

Participants are responsible for their own sales.

As a sign of respect for the public, participants must not take down or remove any part of their booth before closing time set at **5 p.m.**, Sunday, April 28, 2024.

Muffins, coffee and two lunches will be provided throughout the weekend.

The Spring Show Contract includes a list of tasks to be done prior and during the show. Participants will select one task or more among the list to be accepted in this exhibition. They will then be contacted for task details.
